umbers are just numbers, right?
Well, that's what we thought until Australian numerologist Max Coppa, author of the new book Does Your Love Life Add Up?, "did" our digits. Here are a few things we learnt ...

The background

According to Coppa, numerology dates back around 4000 years. "Now we have computers to help us with the number crunching, numerology can reveal a lot about people," says Coppa, adding that a successful businesswoman he knows recruits staff entirely based on their numbers – seriously.

The DIY lesson

First, find what Coppa calls your "life lesson" number by adding your birth date digits. For example, if Jane was born on September 29, 1983, she'd add: 2+9+0+9+1+9+8+3 to get 41. By adding 4 and 1 together, she'd get 5. If your life lesson number is a master number - 11, 22, 33 or 44 don't add them. View these numbers as a more intense version of the single digit. Now, see where your life lesson number falls in the "life grid" below. If you've got the hang of that, add all your birth date digits to the grid. "By putting your numbers in a life grid, you can find out your strengths and weaknesses," says Coppa. Sarah Reid (USID)
